

# Art Amore Camps, Excursions, Classes and COVID-19

**Our young artists safety is our main concern, and here at Art Amore we have taken several steps to ensure a safe and healthy environment.**

**We have made arrangements to stay within, or improve upon, the state and CDC recommended guidelines. We will take the following steps:**

## **GENERAL CAMP & CLASS INFORMATION:**

- We will never have more than 10 artists at a time in camps or excursions.
- Each In-studio class will not exceed 6 artists. This number may be revised in the second half of the summer.
- Each artist and staff member will be thermally scanned with a no-touch thermometer, and if anyone temperature reads higher than 100.4F they will not be allowed to remain.
- Each artist will be evaluated at the beginning of each camp, excursion or class.
- we are encouraging curbside drop-off and pickup.
- We will start each camp with vigorous hand washing and will hand wash after each activity.
- Each artist will have his or her own dedicated supplies, which only they will use.
- The common areas will be disinfected regularly with UV light, sanitizer and bleach wipes.
- Any common supplies, such as the pencil sharpener, will be disinfected with UV light between uses.
- Artists will maintain social distancing during activities, no more than 5 artists at a table.
- Masks will be provided to those who want them.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION SPECIFICALLY FOR EXCURSIONS:**

- When out and about Artists will need to wear a facial covering anytime requested by the location and when viable and logically feasible.
- Artists will be provided with a disposal mask each morning, which they may decorate as they choose though artists are welcome to use their own if they prefer.
- Artists will need to vigorously wash hands before and after any outside activities. Disinfectant will be available for use at any time.
- We have had to change some locations, to ensure the ability to social distance. the new locations will be sent out shortly in the on-boarding email.
- Before and after we go to each site we will be taking time to disinfect before entering the van. Again, our precautions revolve around keeping the studio spaces, the artists and staff and the supplies as clean as possible:
- A student may wash up whenever they want, in addition to the mandated hand washing.
- Disinfectant may be used whenever desired.
- We will be cleaning, uv-ing and wiping down surfaces and shared supplies throughout the day, well beyond our usual high standards.

**It is our expectation that circumstances may require us to implement last minute changes, many of which may be mandated by the city or state, as the summer goes on. We will keep you posted on those changes, as necessary.**
